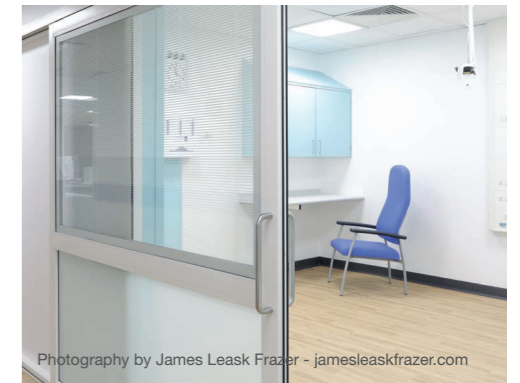
Processes and PPE were transformed during the Covid pandemic, but old-style space designs and furniture continue to make infection-fighting harder.

CASE STUDY

Full FF&E fitout for Balfour Hospital Orkney.

Robertson Construction built this £65 million facility for NHS Orkney that is transforming healthcare services on the islands.

We delivered the full FF&E fitout including wall protection, blinds, bedheads and cubicles, as well as all the fitted furniture. Working closely with the Keppie Design team we also provided reception counters plus bespoke seating for the atrium and café.

As Scotland's first net-zero hospital, the Balfour is making a positive impact on the environment. The materials and built form of the building and surrounding landscape, are simple, robust, easily sourced and maintained; all reflecting Orkney's heritage and ecology.

The Hospital has Physiotherapy and Occupational Therapy Departments, together with Outpatients, Audiology, Radiography, a Pharmacy, the Laboratory, Medical Records and a Central Decontamination Unit.

This multi-award-finalist project presented a unique set of challenges for everyone involved, including the remoteness of the island, local landscape and climate conditions. The project was nevertheless delivered on-time and on-budget.

CASE STUDY

New Primary Care centre is a regeneration centre point.

Situated by the iconic Clydebank crane, the Clydebank Health Centre is improving Primary Care services in the area and forming the central base for community health teams.

Residents can access GP practices, podiatry and physiotherapy services plus consulting and treatment rooms. The new facility is described as forming a 'centre point' within the Queen's Quay regeneration area.

Hygenius (then WorkSpace Design) provided a full group 1 and 2 FF&E package for the consulting rooms, treatment rooms, dirty utilities, clean utilities, storage rooms, offices and staff areas. We also provided bespoke GP reception desks and tea points, including a low-height one for children!

The art on the centre's main reception desk was designed in Glasgow and produced by Hygenius craftsmen who worked with the solid resin surfacing to embed images of the surrounding natural environment of Clydebank. Natural forms such as the shape and texture of the hills, river, lochs and the Cochno stones are at the centre of the design.

CASE STUDY

Award-winning FF&E fitout for Foss Park MH Hospital.

Wates delivered this £28 million York facility for adults and older adults in 2020.

The hospital is part of ongoing community services rather than a long-term place of stay and admission is viewed as the exception rather than the norm.

The beautiful surroundings, natural daylight and muted colours of the interior provide a calm, peaceful environment for patients and staff alike.

Hygenius (then WorkSpace Design) worked very closely with the design team at P+HS, Wates, the NHS trust and service users and carers to design, manufacture and install all the fitted furniture.

This included the specialist bedroom furniture such as wardrobes, desks, beds and units. We also fitted out the receptions, treatment rooms, clean/dirty utilities, ADL kitchens, café/eating areas and storage rooms.

The project won Best Interior Design in the Patient Environment Class at Building Better Healthcare Awards 2020 and was Highly Commended in the Building Design category, Best Healthcare Development over £10M.
