



A stronger NHS cyber risk posture starts with clearer oversight

The pressure on NHS oversight is not getting lighter

That makes assurance harder to build, harder to defend, and harder to act on.

When the picture is fragmented, decisions are weaker

Leadership sees updates, but not always context. Teams produce evidence, but not always a connected view. The result is unnecessary drag in governance, slower assurance cycles, and less certainty around what needs attention first.
