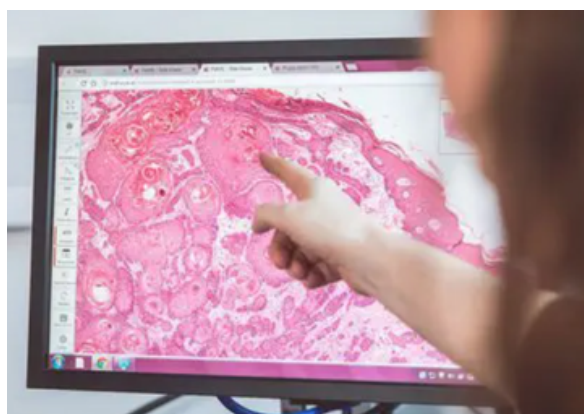

Tutor allows for the management of digital slides as well as the creation and delivery of training content in a virtual laboratory setting. It offers the ability to embed files such as video, presentations, and other graphics.



It has a dedicated tool for testing students and pathologists on whole slide images, allowing learners to view and assess real tumour samples within a virtual microscopy environment. Advanced user management means student access to the platform can be limited during exam season.
